

WISCONSIN STATEWIDE INTELLIGENCE CENTER GRANT FUNDING ACKNOWLEDGEMENT – FISCAL YEAR 2020

This document shall serve as the Funding Acknowledgement between the state of Wisconsin Department of Justice, Division of Criminal Investigation (DCI), Wisconsin Statewide Intelligence Center (WSIC), and Wisconsin Chiefs of Police (WCPA) regarding State use of Homeland Security grant funding on behalf of the Wisconsin Chiefs of Police Association (WCPA).

1. PARTIES. The parties to this acknowledgement are the State of Wisconsin, Department of Justice, Division of Criminal Investigation, Wisconsin Statewide Intelligence Center (WSIC), and the Wisconsin Chiefs of Police Association (WCPA).

2. AUTHORITY. This acknowledgement is authorized under the provisions of Wisconsin Statute 66.0301.

3. PURPOSE. The purpose of this acknowledgement is to set forth terms by which the State of Wisconsin shall expend Homeland Security Grant Funding on behalf of the Wisconsin Chiefs of Police Association (WCPA) to build the cyber capacity of the Wisconsin Statewide Intelligence Center (WSIC). The United States Department of Homeland Security issued 2020 US DHS State Homeland Security Grant Program funding to the State of Wisconsin. Under this grant, the WCPA authorizes the State of Wisconsin to incur costs on behalf of the WCPA, provided that the WCPA and the State of Wisconsin agree to the utilization of grant funds on the project.

The costs incurred by the State of Wisconsin governed by this acknowledgement are costs expressly associated with the Cyber Enhancements for dealing with cyber threats to elections and other cybercrimes which was awarded to DCI under the 2020 US DHS State Homeland Security Grant Program. Grant funds in the amount of \$214,375 will allow the Wisconsin Statewide Intelligence Center (WSIC) to greatly enhance their functionality in responding to, and preventing, cybercrimes and cyber terrorism in Wisconsin. This acknowledgement in no way signifies that the local unit of government is responsible for determining for this funding is ultimately expended. Grant 2020-HSW-10-12152 was awarded to WSIC on 08/31/20.

Execution of the acknowledgment will not result in any costs incurred by WCPA. It will not reduce or limit any future Homeland Security grants which may be applied for by the local unit of government or in any way impact future grant opportunities.

4. RESPONSIBILITIES:

A.) the State of Wisconsin shall:

1. Fully underwrite the cost of sustaining the WSIC that benefits all state and local agencies, including the WCPA, as detailed in the State of Wisconsin's grant award held and managed at Wisconsin Emergency Management.
2. Assume all responsibility for the expenditures covered under this agreement, including any reporting and/or auditing requirements

B.) The Wisconsin Chiefs of Police (WCPA) shall:

1. Sign a WSIC Acknowledgement of Funding that provides authority to the State of Wisconsin to incur costs on behalf of the WCPA and other local agencies in Wisconsin.


6. **OTHER PROVISIONS.** Nothing in this acknowledgement is intended to conflict with current laws or regulations of the State of Wisconsin or WCPA. If a term of this acknowledgement is inconsistent with such authority, then that term shall be invalid, but the remaining terms and conditions of this acknowledgement shall remain in full force and effect. In addition, this acknowledgement will end should Homeland Security program funds no longer be available to the State that appropriate for use for this purpose.

7. **EFFECTIVE DATE.** The terms of this acknowledgement are effective for the term of the current FY2020 Homeland Security Grant Program funding period and all subsequent Homeland Security grant funding.


8. **MODIFICATION.** This acknowledgement may be modified upon the mutual written consent of the parties.

9. **TERMINATION.** The terms of this acknowledgement, as modified with the consent of both parties, will remain in effect until the FY2020 State Homeland Security Grant Program and Grant 2020-HSW-10-12152 are closed, and will remain in effect through perpetuity while the WSIC is funded through subsequent State Homeland Security Grant Program grants. Either party upon 60 days written notice to the other party may terminate this acknowledgement.


