





Under this grant, the State of Wisconsin must allocate grant funding to local units of government. Under this grant, the above-named state agency authorized the State of Wisconsin to incur costs for this project that will have statewide applicability. The costs incurred by the State of Wisconsin are those costs expressly associated with the development and implementation of the WSIC Sustainment – HSGP FY2020 project only, as described in the Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) titled: HS Wisconsin Statewide Intelligence Center (WSIC) Operations and Sustainment 2020 (2021) v2. The cost of this project is expected to be approximately \$850,000.00.
